

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Participation in the activities offered by the AVOSCOOT implies the unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions.

PARTICIPATION

The minimum age for the activity Snowmobiling is:

- 18 years old for pilot
- 6 years old for guide passenger
- From 10 years old to be a passenger behind an adult.

The presentation of a valid identification and driving licence could be required for all rides.

Our structure is committed to do everything possible for your safety, however, we remind you that the activities in the natural environment involve risks and uncertainties.

OUR RATES INCLUDE

- Loan of equipment necessary to practice the activity (snowmobile and helmet).
- Supervision by qualified professionals
- Any activity is due begun.

SECURITY

For your safety and comfort, our structure, reserves the right to modify or cancel service depending on weather conditions.

In this case, our structure will offer a new date for hiking.

The guidelines shall be liable as a professional, therefore, it is the only one to be able to refuse (e) participant (e) if he (she) does not require the conditions requested.

The customer also makes a commitment to have no medical contraindication in the practice of the activity snowmobile.

RESPONSIBILITY

Our policy of professional liability insurance is underwritten by LESTIENNE Company under No. RC22688-2017.

Our structure is liable only for damages resulting from equipment failure. The customer is solely responsible for property damage and injury resulting from his act.

MATERIAL

Equipment and facilities are licensed and comply with EEC standards.

Each participant will read the rules of conduct for the organization of the trip. This document will be signed by the client and any breakage occurred during the trip will be billed separately.

The customer must use the equipment correctly with diligence and must comply with the guidelines and instructions given by professionals.

The customer is responsible for the use of rented equipment.

The customer is solely responsible for any damages or breakages to equipment incurred during his snowmobiling session. He agrees to repay AVOSCOOT all necessary costs to repair equipment damaged as a result of his actions.

The pilot remains solely responsible for physical damage to property, wounds and death resulting from his fact.

RULES OF CONDUCT

- Accelerate gently and not by blows
- Always look on the inside of the turn (left turn, it sways to the right)
- Gain the right, look left and vice versa (counterweight)
- In downhill, lean toward the rear of the vehicle
- Never remove his feet from walking feet
- Keep a safe distance regular 10 to 20 meters between each vehicle
- At each difficulty by a snowmobile, you have an obligation to stop and wait until the snowmobile is out
- Respect our environment and being courteous

SAFETY

- No alcohol steering the snowmobile
- It is forbidden to overtake the snowmobile in front of you.
- Adhering to the Code of Conduct
- Smoking is forbidden on the snowmobiles and on the circuit
- Don't leave traces of the professional

Any breach of these rules will result in immediate expulsion from the trip without any compensation
